- It is strongly suggested that you take the NYS Liberal Arts & Science Test (LAST) during the time you are completing the first 9 credits in your masters degree program.

 - Pass the NYS Teacher Certification Exams www.nystce.nesinc.com/
 - Complete a criminal background check with fingerprinting, as required by New York State law;
 - Apply on-line for New York State certification through the NYS Office of Teaching Initiatives. www.highered.nysed.gov/tcert/
