3. It is strongly suggested that you take the NYS Liberal Arts & Science Test (LAST) during the time you are completing the first 9 credits in your masters degree program.
4. In addition to satisfying the requirements for the degree, teacher candidates must also:
 - apply for graduation through Student Services Office. (dates are listed in Course Schedule)
 - pass the NYS Teacher Certification Exams www.nystce.nesinc.com/
 - complete a criminal background check with fingerprinting, as required by New York State law;
 - apply on-line for New York State certification through the NYS Office of Teaching Initiatives. www.highered.nysed.gov/tcert/
