

JUROR

Jeffrey Hoone is a photographer and Director of Light Work, and artist-run non-profit photography center in Syracuse, NY.

As a photographer Mr. Hoone has exhibited his work most recently at P.P.O.W. Gallery in New York City, the University of Rochester, and his work was included in the Everson Biennial at the Everson Museum of Art in Syracuse, New York.

Mr. Hoone has been the Director of Light Work since 1982 and is responsible for all aspects of the organization whose main goal is to support artists working in photography and electronic imaging. During his tenure at Light Work the organization has invited over 250 artists to participate in their Artist-in-Residence program, produced over 175 internationally distributed publications, and exhibited the work of numerous artists primarily in solo exhibitions. Light Work also has a permanent collection of over 2,000 photographs made primarily by artists who have participated in its Artist-in-Residence program.

In 1989 Light Work received the New York State Governor's Art Award for excellence, and this year Light Work received the highest grant in their category from both the New York State Council on the Arts and the National Endowment for the Arts.

Mr. Hoone has served on many state and national peer review panels including NYSCA, the NEA, and The Massachusetts Council on the Arts.
