### ADMISSION PLANS

#### First-Year Students

##### Regular Admission

- Applicants to all majors will be notified of their admission status on a rolling basis after March 1 for Fall admission and after September 1 for Spring admission.

##### Early Action

- If Sage College of Albany is your first choice, the Office of Admission encourages you to apply under the Early Action Plan. An application and all supporting documents (outlined in the “Application Requirements and Common Application Instructions” below) must be submitted by December 1 for Early Action I and February 1 for Early Action II.
- If you wish to apply for financial aid, you should submit the Early Financial Aid Estimator Form when you apply for admission. The Early Estimator is available through Sage’s Office of Student Services.

#### Transfer Students

Applicants to all majors will be notified of their admission status on a rolling basis after March 1 for Fall admission and September 1 for Spring admission.

#### Students Seeking Financial Aid:

Students seeking financial aid should submit:

- the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to the appropriate processing center by March 1 (the federal school code number for SCA is 002810)
- New York State residents will receive a pre-printed application for the Tuition Assistance Program (Sage TAP code: 0675) when the completed FAFSA has been processed. The forms are available at [www.fafsa.edu.gov](http://www.fafsa.edu.gov).

- High School Transcript:** Submit an official high school transcript, including a listing of courses in progress.
- Recommendation.** From your 11th- or 12th-grade teacher and/or from your secondary school counselor. You can use the Common Application Teacher Evaluation and School Report forms located on the Common Application website or the Sage College of Albany Admission website at [albany.sage.edu/admission/](http://albany.sage.edu/admission/).
- Test Scores:** Send your scores from either the Scholastic Reasoning Test (SAT) of the College Entrance Examination Board or the American College Test (ACT). Sage's CEEB Code is 2343. SAT and ACT test results are optional for students who rank in the top 20 percent of your graduating class.
  - You do not need to submit scores if you graduated from high school more than five years ago.
  - If you are applying to the accelerated Doctor of Physical Therapy program, you must submit SAT or ACT scores.
- Portfolio Review:** Students seeking admission to the Visual Arts program must complete a portfolio review. Please call (518) 292-1730 to schedule an appointment.
- Personal Essay:** Topics are listed on the Common Application.
- Personal Interview:** Although not required, a personal interview is highly recommended, either on campus or with an alumna/us in your area.
