Articulation Agreement

Objective

This Articulation Agreement facilitates the transfer of qualified students enrolled at Hudson Valley Community College (HVCC) into the Psychology (B.S) program at Sage College of Albany(SPCE) Counselors at HVCC may use this articulation agreement to advise current students who express interest in the SCA Psychology program.

Terms of the Agreement

This Articulation agreement, once signed, will be effective immediately. Hereafter, it must be reviewed and reapproved at least every two years to remain in effect. Reapproval of this agreement, including any modifications, requires the signatures of Department Chairs and appropriate administrators at HVCC and SCA.

All of the current published rules for accepting transfer students into programs at SCA apply. This Agreement supplements, but does not supercede or replace, the language of the latest SCA Catalog.

SCA agrees to accept for transfer into the B.S. program in Psychology up to 66 credit hours earned by a student at HVCC. Only courses with earned grades of C- or better will transfer. This Agreement covers courses taken at HVCC only. Course credits on a student's transcript from other institutions are subject to the published SCA rules for accepting transfer credit.

If a student at HVCC wishes to transfer to SCA without having completed the associate's degree, he or she is assured that courses with grades of C- or better will transfer. In this case, however, Junior year status and outright admission into the Psychology program are not guaranteed. Junior status will be attained at SCA by transferring 54 or more credits. All HVCC transfer students must meet with a Psychology advisor at SCA to plan their courses and to determine how many semesters of further study are required for degree completion.
