Articulation Agreement between Russell Sage College and Schenectady County Community College



Objective

To provide an opportunity for those qualified students at Schenectady County Community College (SCCC) who wish to pursue a BS in Education to enter Russell Sage College as juniors and complete their BS degree.

Terms of the Agreement

Russell Sage College agrees to accept for transfer into the BS program up to 60 credit hours earned by a student at SCCC who takes the courses listed below. Only courses with earned grades of C or better will transfer. An overall GPA of 2.75 is required.

This agreement will be reviewed at least once every two years. It can be renegotiated at the request of either institution, especially if there is substantial change in relevant curricula at either institutions.

This agreement covers courses taken at SCCC only. If a student from SCCC has credits on his/her transcript from other 2-year or 4-year institutions, the published Russell Sage rules for accepting transfer credit from those institutions will apply to those credits.

If a student from SCCC wishes to transfer without having completed all of the courses in this Agreement, he/she is assured that the identified equivalent courses with grades of C or better will transfer.
