

## Articulation Agreement between Russell Sage and Schenectady County Community College

### Objective

To provide an opportunity for those qualified female students who have graduated from Schenectady County Community College (SCCC) who wish to pursue a BS in Nutrition Science degree offered at Russell Sage College (RSC) to enter RSC as juniors and complete the BS in 2 years of fulltime study at The Sage Colleges.

### Terms of the Agreement

Published standards of admission to Russell Sage College apply.

RSC agrees to accept for transfer into the BS in Nutrition Science up to 60 credit hours earned by a female student who is a graduate at SCCC who takes the courses listed below. Only courses with earned grades of C- or better will transfer. SCCC women who complete courses listed below with grades of C- or better; and who attain a combined grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 will be automatically admitted into the RSC Nutrition Science program.

This agreement will be reviewed at least once every two years. It can be renegotiated at the request of either institution, especially if there is substantial change in relevant curricula at either institution.


This agreement covers courses taken at SCCC only. If a student from SCCC has credits on her transcript from other 2-year or 4-year institutions, the published RSC rules for accepting transfer credit from those institutions will apply to those credits.
