I. General Statement of Purpose

This document establishes a formal Memorandum of Understanding between the SUNY Cobleskill's Bachelor of Science in Applied Psychology degree program and The Sage College's Master of Arts in Counseling and Community Psychology and Master of Arts in Community Psychology graduate degree programs.

The purpose is to facilitate the admission of qualified SUNY Cobleskill Bachelor of Science in Applied Psychology degree recipients into The Sage College's Master of Arts in Counseling and Community Psychology and Master of Arts in Community Psychology graduate degree programs.

II. Requirements and Terms

- A. Students must earn a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above at the time of application to the graduate program, and maintain an overall GPA of 3.0 or above at the time of completion and graduation with the Bachelor of Science in Applied Psychology degree.
- B. Students will receive a minimum grade of "C" or better on all required courses for the Bachelor of Science degree in Applied Psychology at SUNY Cobleskill, resulting in a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- C. Completion of the Bachelor of Science in Applied Psychology at SUNY Cobleskill.
- D. Students will meet the academic requirements for admission including specific coursework as outlined on the attached guide sheets.
- E. Completion of the admissions application for The Sage College's Master of Arts in Counseling and Community Psychology or the Master of Arts in Community Psychology graduate degree program.
- F. Students will provide The Sage College with a final transcript listing degree posted and cumulative GPA for the Bachelor of Science in Applied Psychology degree program.

III. Benefits and Advantages

- A. Admission to The Sage College's Master of Arts in Counseling and Community Psychology graduate degree program, leading to licensure as a Mental Health Counselor in New York State, for qualified SUNY Cobleskill students.
- B. To attract qualified students to both institutions who wish to pursue a Master's degree leading to licensure as a Mental Health Counselor in New York State, for qualified SUNY Cobleskill students completing the Master of Arts in Counseling and Community Psychology graduate degree program. To attract qualified students from both institutions who wish to pursue a Master's degree in Community Psychology which will prepare graduates to utilize the systems, practices and tools needed to effectively address mental health and community welfare issues.

IV. Review and Revision of this Memorandum of Understanding

This agreement will be reviewed every two years in April, starting with the year of inception. Should either party desire to terminate this agreement, notification will be given to the other party, in writing, not less than six months prior to the proposed date of termination.
