The Sage Colleges' Commencement Ceremony will be held on Saturday, May 11, 2019. Under The Sage Colleges' academic policies, all Sage Colleges students must have completed all degree requirements in order to participate in the Commencement ceremony. In order to participate prior to completing degree requirements, you MUST be cleared by the office of the Registrar. Candidates who completed degree requirements at an earlier date (the prior August or December) may participate in the May ceremony. The Registrar's office will mail diplomas to all graduates by the end of June.

ALL STUDENTS MUST RESPOND TO THIS LETTER TO CONFIRM WHETHER OR NOT YOU WILL PARTICIPATE IN THE COMMENCEMENT CEREMONY BY APRIL 5, 2019. Formal academic regalia-- cap, tassel, gown and hood—are required to participate in Commencement. You will need to order academic regalia online at <u>https://collegegrad.herffjones.com</u> (type "Sage" in the search bar on the welcome page and select your appropriate college). The deadline for free delivery to the Bookstore is March 23rd. Note that you will need to know which degree you are earning (Bachelor of Arts, Bachelor of Business Administration, Bachelor of Fine Arts, or Bachelor of Science), so please verify this with the registrar's office in advance, if needed. This information is also available on your program evaluation in SageAdvisor. Students can request home delivery for an extra fee and must do so by April 15th. Students will be notified when their regalia has arrived at the Bookstore; all regalia must be paid for at the time of purchase online.

Verify your participation in commencement online:

Students must respond online by <u>Friday, April 5, 2019</u> to verify whether or not you plan to participate in commencement in order to be included in the ceremony. No exceptions will be made. Students not intending to participate must also verify this online. To do so, go to: www.sage.edu/commencement and click the link for "Commencement Participation Form."

Photographer:

An official photographer has been retained for the ceremony. Candidates will be photographed as they receive their diploma case. No one else will be permitted to photograph in the stage area and candidates' section during the ceremony. Proofs will be mailed directly to graduates from the photographer with information about ordering.

Guests:

Due to the large seating capacity of the Field House, tickets are not necessary for admission to Commencement, but we ask you to limit your guests to no more than six. You will not be permitted to reserve seats prior to the event. The Field House will open at 8:30 a.m. on Saturday morning, at which time guests may choose their seats. Someone **must** remain with the seats at all times. **Seats cannot be saved after 9:15 a.m.**

Parking:

Parking immediately around the RPI Field House is very limited. We have made arrangements for parking and shuttle service from Troy High School and Troy Middle School. Note that the Field House has a limited number of spaces available in a parking lot reserved for those with disability plates or placards. Note that if this lot is full, guests will be permitted drive up to the entrance to drop off individuals with disabilities. **Please allow extra time for parking on Commencement day.**

Other:

- If you or one of your guests have a disability that will require special accommodation during the commencement ceremony, please notify the Office of Student Life at 518-244-2207.
- No alcohol will be permitted at this event. Possession of liquor during the ceremony will disqualify you from participating. RPI is also a **tobacco free** campus.
- Pets are not allowed at the Field House.
