

The Sage Colleges 2019-20 Summer Aid Information Sheet

The Financial Aid staff is here to help you address your summer 2019 aid needs. Below is important information regarding financial aid for the summer 2019 Semester. Please review all of the information below so you are well informed as a summer financial aid recipient.

Process:

- o Complete a 2019-2020 FAFSA online.
 - You must have a 2019-2020 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) on file prior to applying for summer 2019 financial aid. If you have not done this, please go to www.fafsa.gov and submit your FAFSA now.
- Register for summer 2019 classes. Please submit your form <u>AFTER</u> you have registered for your summer classes.
- Complete the Summer Aid Application and return to the Financial Aid Office no later than June 21, 2019, however in order to receive your financial aid package before the tuition due date (May 1, 2019), you must submit your summer intent application at least 2 weeks prior to 05/01/19. Applications will be accepted starting April 1, 2019 through June 21, 2019. Applications can be returned in person or by mail.

- If you are eligible, the Financial Aid Office will put together your financial aid package and notify you that your award letter has been updated on SageAdvisor, under My Sage Aid. Review your online financial aid package and accept or decline any financial aid awards you are offered.
- If you are awarded a Stafford Loan and you are a first time borrower at The Sage Colleges, you must complete a
 Direct Loan Master Promissory Note and Direct Loan Entrance Interview. Both of these can be completed at
 www.studentloans.gov.

YOU WILL NOT RECEIVE A SUMMER FINANCIAL AID PACKAGE IF YOU DO NOT COMPLETE THE ABOVE STEPS.

THE FINAL DATE THAT SUMMER AID APPLICATIONS WILL BE PROCESSED IS JUNE 21 2019. NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE TO THIS DEADLINE.

Summer Aid Information:

- Students must meet all Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) requirements in order to receive summer aid. SAP is not reviewed until after spring 2019 grades are posted in May so it may be possible for someone to receive a financial aid award notice for summer 2019 prior to May, only to have it revoked after SAP is reviewed. If you are unsure of your SAP status based on your anticipated spring 2019 performance, please consult with a financial aid advisor. More information on Sage's SAP policy can be found at www.sage.edu.
- Institutional money, Federal SEOG and Federal Work Study are **not** available for the summer 2019 semester.
 Financial aid in the summer primarily consists of Federal Direct Stafford Loans, Federal Direct Parent PLUS loans,
 and Federal Direct Grad PLUS loans. In some cases the Federal Pell Grant or NYS Tuition Assistance Program
 (TAP) Grant may be available.
- Students must be accepted into an approved program of study and enrolled at least half-time. For financial aid purposes, half-time status for undergraduate students is 6 credit hours and for graduate students is 4.5 credit hours.
 All credit hours taken throughout the summer sessions are combined to determine a student's overall summer term enrollment status for financial aid.
- If your financial aid application was selected for verification, you must complete the verification process in order to receive a financial aid award package. Please note that verification must be completed prior to May 31, 2019 in order to receive financial aid for the summer semester.
- If your enrollment of 6 credits (undergraduate) or 4.5 credits (graduate) is between two summer sessions, your Stafford loans will not be disbursed until after the beginning of the second summer session.
- If you drop below half-time status before loan proceeds are disbursed, and you have failed to establish eligibility for the loan, the entire amount of the loan must be returned to the lender.
- If you withdraw from your classes, stop attending without formally withdrawing, or never attend your classes, you
 may be subject to having all or a portion of your aid returned. This may result in a balance due and require
 immediate payment to Student Accounts. If you received a refund you may be required to repay all or a portion of
 your summer refund check(s).
- Book money is not available for the summer semester so please plan accordingly.
- The final date that summer aid applications will be processed will be June 21, 2019.
