AlcoholEdu and Sexual Assault Prevention courses are now available starting Monday, December 16th 2019. *All new students are expected to complete Part 1 of both courses by Monday, January 20th 2020, which is <u>before</u> the start of classes.

You are expected to complete <u>both</u> AlcoholEdu and Sexual Assault Prevention. You will need <u>one</u> EverFi Higher Education Account to access the course(s) from your dashboard.

To fulfill The Sage Colleges' requirement:

- Go to: http://www.everfi.com/login and click Register
- Under "Student/Learner", enter the Registration Code: 73f17856 to create your EverFi Account
 - Note: When prompted, please enter your 9 digit Student ID number to receive credit for completion. You can look-up your ID number on your Sage ID card, your account statement, or your schedule.
- Complete Part 1 of <u>AlcoholEdu</u> and Sexual Assault Prevention by <u>Monday</u>, <u>January 20th</u>, <u>2020</u>.
- After 15 days you will receive an invitation to complete Part 2 of AlcoholEdu and Sexual Assault Prevention, which must be completed by *Monday*, *February 17th 2020*.

Other Important Information:

- You will need Internet access and audio capabilities.
- To avoid technical issues, please use any major web browser (e.g., Firefox, Internet Explorer, Google Chrome) released within the previous two years.
- You may take the course(s) in multiple sittings.
- The course(s) may include surveys to help personalize your experience and measure participants' attitudes and behaviors. *All survey responses are confidential*; the school will only receive information about the participant group as a whole and will never see individual answers.
- Should you experience problems, technical support is available 24/7 and can be accessed from the "Help" link within the course.
