I. General Statement of Purpose

This document establishes a formal Memorandum of Understanding between the SUNY Cobleskill's Bachelor of Science in Applied Psychology degree program and Russell Sage College's Master of Arts in Counseling and Community Psychology and Master of Arts in Community Psychology graduate degree programs.

The purpose is to facilitate the admission of qualified SUNY Cobleskill Bachelor of Science in Applied Psychology degree recipients into Russell Sage College's Master of Arts in Counseling and Community Psychology and Master of Arts in Community Psychology graduate degree programs.

II. Requirements and Terms

- A. Students must earn a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above at the time of application to the graduate program, and maintain an overall GPA of 3.0 or above at the time of completion and graduation with the Bachelor of Science in Applied Psychology degree.
- B. Students will receive a minimum grade of "C" or better on all required courses for the Bachelor of Science degree in Applied Psychology at SUNY Cobleskill, resulting in a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- C. Completion of the Bachelor of Science in Applied Psychology program at SUNY Cobleskill.
- D. Students will meet the academic requirements for admission including specific coursework as outlined on the attached guide sheets.
- E. Completion of the admissions application for Russell Sage College's Master of Arts in Counseling or Community Psychology or Master of Arts in Community Psychology graduate degree program.
- F. Students will provide Russell Sage College with a final transcript listing degree posted and cumulative GPA for the Bachelor of Science in Applied Psychology degree program.
