Sage Articulation Agreement

As of January 2019, Sage Articulation applies to Siena Students who:

• graduate from Siena College with at least a 3.0 average in their area of concentration (i.e. a major, or its equivalent in a subject area), at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA, and complete the Teacher Preparation Program, thus making them eligible for initial certification prior to being admitted to Sage Colleges

OR

• graduate from Siena College with a minor in Educational Studies with at least a 3.0 average in their area of concentration (i.e. a major, or its equivalent in a subject area) and at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA

Benefits:

- 1. A waived application fee
- 2. Two courses waived*:
 - a. EDU 201, Education in Society (Siena College EDUC 210, Issues in Contemporary American Education equivalent)
 - b. EDU 206, Educational Psychology (Siena College EDUC 260, Educational Psychology equivalent)
- 3. Option for a third class to be waived at the discretion of Sage Colleges.

This agreement would apply to students going into the following fields of study at Sage:

- Childhood/Literacy Education (M.S.)
- Childhood/Special Education (M.S.)
- Literacy Education Birth-Grade 6 or Grades 5-12 (M.S.Ed)
- Literacy/Special Education (M.S.)
- School Health Education (M.S.)
