

Articulation Agreement between Hudson Valley Community College Community Health Navigation, A.A.S., and Health and Wellness Studies, A.S. and Russell Sage College, Public Health, B.S.

Objective

This articulation agreement is intended to facilitate the transfer of qualified students currently enrolled in the Community Health Navigation, A.A.S., and Health and Wellness Studies, A.S.at Hudson Valley Community College (HVCC) into the applicable B.S. Public Health program at Russell Sage College (RSC). Counselors at Hudson Valley Community College should use the information in this agreement to advise current and future students as to which HVCC courses should be taken prior to application for transfer as they express an interest in the Public Health program at RSC.

Terms of Agreement

This articulation agreement once signed will be in effect immediately (April 15, 2021), and must be reviewed and re-approved in the same manner at least once every five years, in order to remain in effect (by April 15, 2026).

The procedures of review and re-approval shall be as follows:

RSC's Public Health program director in consultation with the Interdisciplinary Studies Department Chairperson reviews the latest available catalogs of the two institutions and prepares the revised draft. A final draft is signed by the department chairs of both institutions and by the appropriate administrator at both institutions.

All of the most-recently published rules for accepting transfer students into programs at RSC apply. This agreement supplements, but does not supersede or replace what was written in the most current RSC catalog.

RSC agrees to accept and transfer into the B.S. in Public Health (as itemized on the following pages) up to 66 credit hours by the student at HVCC. All of the HVCC course and proposed equivalent courses at RSC are listed below. Only courses of earned grades of C or better will transfer to RSC, and students who attain a combined Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.5 in courses will automatically be admitted into the RSC program. This agreement only covers courses taken at HVCC. If students from HVCC have credits on their transcripts from other institutions, the published RSC rules for accepting transfer credit will apply to those credits. If students from HVCC wish to transfer without having completed all of the courses in this agreement, they are assured that the identified equivalent courses with a grade of C or better will transfer, but outright admission into the program will not be guaranteed. If admitted, and if 54 or more of the credits are transferred, junior status at RSC will be attained. All transfer students must meet with the appropriate RSC advisor to plan their courses and to determine how many additional semesters are required for degree completion.
