



Parent(s) Marital Status Reports Both Parents Living Together

Dear Student,

You indicated on your 2022-2023 FAFSA that your parents' marital status is "Unmarried and Both Parents Living Together." If this marital status is used, income information from both parents must be reported on the FAFSA, even if they are not able to file a joint tax return with the IRS. Your FAFSA appears to only have 1 income reported.

If both of your parents worked and filed a Federal Tax Return with the IRS for 2020, please update your FAFSA with both incomes. You can make the correction by logging in to your FAFSA (www.studentaid.gov) and updating questions #84-92. Remember, you should answer these questions about both of your parents so you may have to add numbers together to get a total amount to enter for each question.
