

Articulation Agreement between Columbia-Greene Community College, Criminal Justice, A.A. and Russell Sage College, Interdisciplinary Studies Department, Criminal Justice, Law, and Behavioral Science, B.S.

Objective

This articulation agreement is intended to facilitate the transfer of qualified students currently enrolled in the A.A. Criminal Justice at Columbia-Greene Community College (CGCC) into the B.S. Criminal Justice, Law, and Behavioral Science (CJL&BS) program at Russell Sage College (RSC). Counselors at CGCC should use the information in this agreement to advise current and future students as they express an interest in the CJL&BS program at RSC as to which RSC courses should be taken prior to application for transfer.

Terms of Agreement

This articulation agreement once signed will be in effect immediately (September 16, 2022) and must be reviewed and re-approved in the same manner at least once every five years, in order to remain in effect (September 16, 2027).

The procedures of review and re-approval shall be as follows:

RSC's Program Director for CJL&BS reviews the latest available catalogs of the two institutions and prepares the revised draft. A final draft is signed by the appropriate administrators at both institutions.

All the most-recently published rules for accepting transfer students into programs at RSC apply. This agreement supplements but does not supersede or replace what was written in the most current RSC catalog.

Criminal Justice, A.A. at Columbia-Greene Community College and Criminal Justice, Law, and Behavioral Science B.S. at Russell Sage College

RSC agrees to accept and transfer into the Criminal Justice, Law, and Behavioral Science B.S. program up to 66 credit hours by the student at CGCC. Only courses of earned grades of C- or better will transfer, and students who attain a combined Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.5 in courses will automatically be admitted into the RSC program. This agreement only covers courses taken at CGCC. If students from CGCC have credits on their transcripts from other institutions, the published RSC rules for accepting transfer credit will apply to those credits. If students from CGCC wish to transfer without having completed all the courses in this agreement, they are assured that the identified equivalent courses with a grade of C- or better will transfer, but outright admission into the program will not be guaranteed. If admitted, and if 54 or more of the credits are transferred, junior status at RSC will be attained.



All transfer students must meet with a CJL&BS advisor to plan their courses and to determine how many additional semesters are required for degree completion. Students interested in eventually transferring to RSC through this articulation agreement are encouraged to contact the Director of Transfer Admission (transfer@sage.edu) to discuss transferring to RSC. Some of the equivalent courses are listed below.
