Articulation Agreement between **SUNY Adirondack, *Fine Arts A.S.*** and **Russell Sage College, *Art + Extended Media, B.F.A.***

Objective

This articulation agreement is intended to facilitate the transfer of qualified students currently enrolled in ***Fine Arts A.S.*** program at **SUNY Adirondack (SUNY ADK)** into the ***Art + Extended Media, B.F.A.*** program at **Russell Sage College (RSC)**. Counselors at **SUNY ADK** can use information in this agreement to advise students as they express an interest in the ***Art + Extended Media, B.F.A.*** program as to which courses should be taken prior to application for transfer.

Terms of Agreement

The latest available catalogs of the two institutions are reviewed by the appropriate Department Chairs from each institution. Department chairs of both institutions, and the appropriate administrator of both institutions, must sign the revised documents.

This articulation agreement, once signed, will be effective immediately and must be reviewed and re-approved in the same manner at least once every three years hereafter in order to remain in effect. It can be renegotiated at the request of either institution, especially if there is substantial change in relevant curricula at either institution. Either college may amend or terminate the agreement, giving the other one year written notice.

Fine Arts A.S. at **SUNY Adirondack**

and

Art + Extended Media, B.F.A. at **Russell Sage College**

Russell Sage College agrees to accept and transfer into the ***Art + Extended Media, B.F.A.*** program up to **63** credits earned by the student at **SUNY ADK** and who takes the courses listed below. Only courses of earned grades of C- or better will qualify for transfer, and the students who attain a combined Grade Point Average (GPA) of a **3.0** in courses will automatically be admitted into the ***Art + Extended Media, B.F.A.*** program at **Russell Sage College**.

This agreement covers courses taken at **SUNY ADK** only. If students from **SUNY ADK** have credits on their transcripts from other institutions, the Russell Sage College rules for accepting transferred credit will apply to those credits.
