Articulation Agreement between **Hudson Valley Community College and Russell Sage College, Bachelor of Science in Psychology.**

Objective

This articulation agreement is intended to facilitate the transfer of qualified students currently enrolled in the **Associate of Arts Program at Hudson Valley Community College (HVCC)** into the **Psychology** program at **Russell Sage College**. Counselors at **HVCC** can use the information in this agreement to advise current students as they express an interest in the **Psychology** program as to which courses should be taken prior to application for transfer.

Terms of Agreement

The latest available catalogs of the two institutions are reviewed by the appropriate Department Chairs from each institution. Department chairs of both institutions and the appropriate administrator of both institutions must sign the revised documents.

This articulation agreement, once signed, will be effective immediately and must be reviewed and re-approved in the same manner at least once every three years hereafter in order to remain in effect. It can be renegotiated at the request of either institution, especially if there is substantial change in relevant curricula at either institution. Either college may amend or terminate the agreement, giving the other one year written notice.

Program Name at Transfer Institution and Program Name at Russell Sage College

Russell Sage College agrees to accept and transfer into the **Psychology** program up to **64** credits earned by the student at **HVCC** and who takes the courses listed below. Only courses of earned grades of C- or better will qualify for transfer, and the students who attain a combined Grade Point Average (GPA) of a **2.5** in courses will automatically be admitted into the **Psychology** program.

This agreement covers courses taken at **HVCC** only. If students from **HVCC** have credits on their transcripts from other institutions, the Russell Sage College rules for accepting transferred credit will apply to those credits.

**It is strongly suggested that HVCC students take a MATH Elective rather than BADM 220 or MATH 135, they cannot have two statistics courses transfer in (they are taking PSYC 275)

*** Students taking a 3-credit science or math at HVCC will have additional liberal arts or general education elective credits.
