

**Articulation Agreement between Central Valley WIC Dietetic Internship and
Russell Sage College School of Health Sciences
Nutrition Science Department**

This Articulation Agreement allows Central Valley WIC Dietetic Internship students to complete the **Master of Science in Applied Nutrition** program at the Russell Sage College Graduate Schools.

This Articulation Agreement provides for:

- Preferred acceptance (on a space available basis) into the MS in Applied Nutrition at Russell Sage College for students who have a) been accepted to the Central Valley WIC Dietetic Internship, b) obtained a 3.0 or higher undergraduate degree GPA.
- Waiver of the Russell Sage College Graduate Schools application fee
- Access to Sage advisors to coordinate course scheduling.
- Access to Sage Student Services, including financial aid, registrar, and library services.

Central Valley WIC Dietetic Internship partners agree to:

- Advise and support students to ensure success

This agreement will apply to students from the Central Valley WIC Dietetic Internship enrolled beginning in 2026. This agreement will be reviewed at least once every two years. It can be renegotiated at the request of either institution, especially if there is substantial change in relevant curricula at either institution. Either college may terminate the agreement, giving the other one year written notice. Offers by Russell Sage College Graduate Schools for admission tendered to students prior to termination shall remain valid and will be honored by Russell Sage College Graduate Schools for the year they were offered. The Chairs/Program Directors of the respective departments will be responsible for the implementation of the agreement.

To guarantee placement in the Applied Nutrition Program, students agree to submit the following information and to meet these requirements:

By April 30th for Summer or Fall admission:

1. Completed RSC Graduate School application online (fee waived, essay waived, reference letters waived).
2. Obtain official transcripts from all college institutions attended.
